## Competences

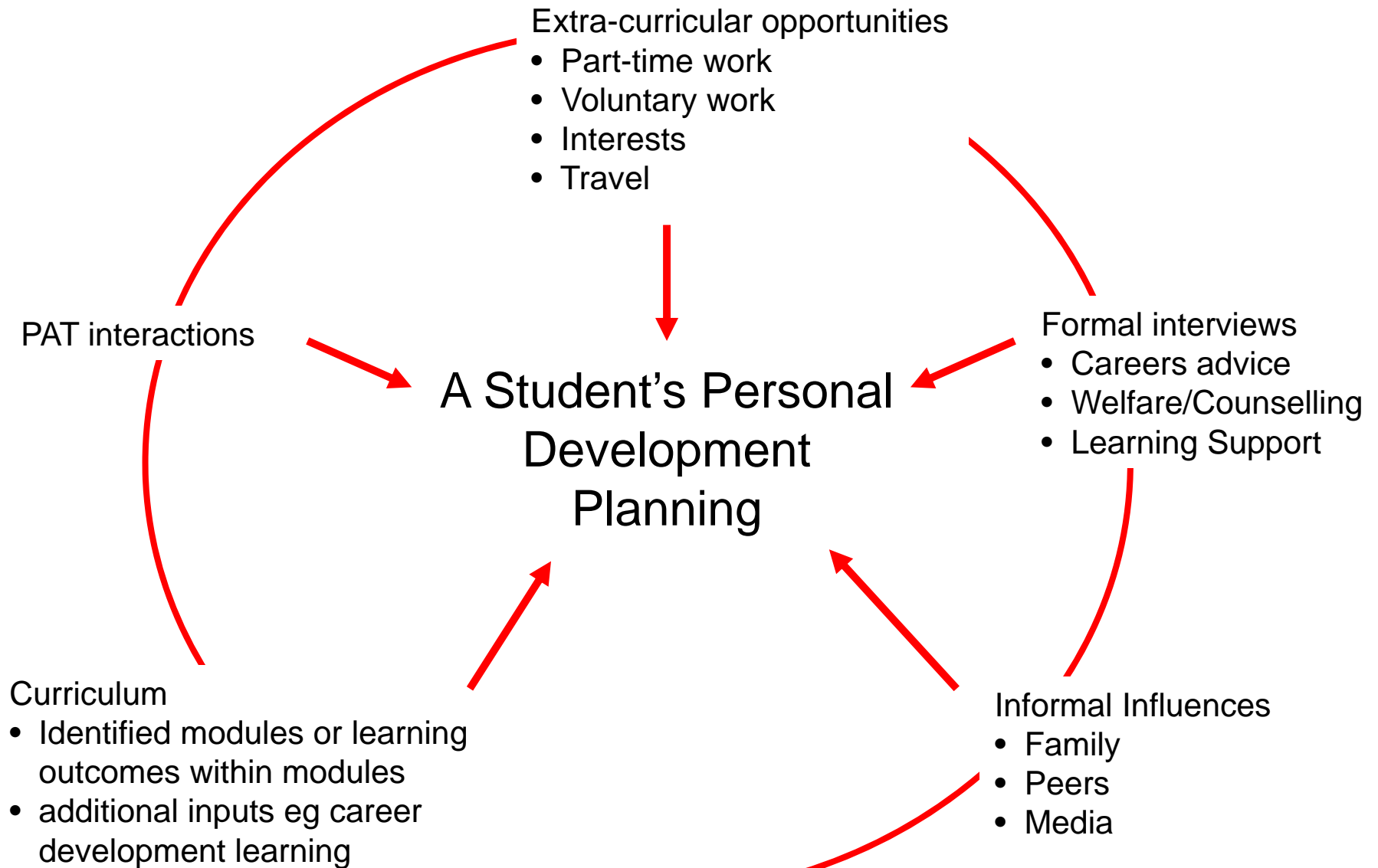
- Cognitive skills
